

Installation Instructions

- Do not touch luminaire while lamp is on. Turn off/unplug and allow to cool before replacing lamp.
- 2. Lamp gets HOT quickly! Contact only switch/plug when turning on.
- 3. Do not touch hot luminaire or mount option.
- 4. Keep lamp away from materials that may burn.
- 5. Do not touch lamp at any time. Use a soft cloth. Oil from your skin may damage lamp.
- Do not operate the luminaire or mount option with damaged or missing parts.
- Do not disassemble mount option.

Installation

Mounting Luminaire

- 1. Feed the two leads of the Luminaire thru the mount hole in the
- 2. Insert the Luminaire knuckle into the Canopy mount hole.
- 3. Feed the two leads of the Luminaire thru the Lock Nut.
- 4. Tighten the Lock Nut to attach the Luminaire to the Canopy.

Electrical Connections

- 1. Feed the Low Voltage Supply Cable through the Wiring Hole on the bottom of the Canopy.
- 2. Attach the Low Voltage Supply Cable to the Luminaire leads by using watertight connectors. Note: Check that the Luminaire and supply cable are rated for the supply power.
- 3. Tuck all wiring and connectors into the Canopy.

Final Mounting

- 1. Position the Canopy on the Tree so the Luminaire is aimed in the desired direction.
- 2. Mount the Canopy to the Tree using Nails or Screws sized appropriately for holding the weight of the Luminaire and Canopy to the Tree.
- 3. Secure the Low Voltage Supply Cable to the Tree.
- Inspect all wiring connections.
- 5. Connect to low voltage source power.
